We are very pleased to inform you of an exciting external visit opportunity relating to the GCSE music course. The trip details are as follows:

Date of Trip: 18th October 2024

Departure Time: We will be leaving school around 12.15pm to enable a timely 1pm arrival.

Means of Transport: Coach

Arrival Time Home: The concert ends at 3pm and therefore we anticipate arriving back at school for 4pm (traffic dependent!) You are responsible for making safe arrangements with your child to travel home once we arrive back at school.

Cost of Trip: £6.50 which must be paid via ParentPay before Friday 4th October.

Consent to attend

Consent for your child to attend must be given under the trips section of the Arbor app and payment must be paid via ParentPay before the deadline above.

Clothing

Students will be required to come in full school uniform as normal.

Food

Students will meet in the **refectory** at **11.40am** where they will have the opportunity to collect and eat lunch before we leave site.
