Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for all of your support for students so far in year 11 – our students have been working really hard and we are looking forward to seeing what they can achieve over the mock period and beyond.

Our year 11 continue to work towards Gaining at least a Grade in all of their subjects – again when grades are awarded in March following the exam series, a number of prizes will be available for students gaining grades across the most subjects, including trips or leavers hoodies for year 11.
